Half term 1 (Sept—Oct)

The purpose of these homework tasks is to achieve two things:

- 1) To **revise and review the work from last year on the History of Medicine** in order to reduce the big revision burden at the end by keeping it ‘ticking over’ during the year.
- 2) To **gain confidence with the styles of exam questions asked.** The exams are becoming more challenging and you need to have plenty of practise at the styles of questions asked so nothing freaks you out in the real exams.

Week 6

Paper 1—History of Medicine



A fourteenth-century drawing of people whipping themselves.

What can you learn from this source about medicine in the Middle Ages? (8 marks)

Use the source and your own knowledge to answer this question.

Help Box

Start with what the source shows/suggests

How can you link that with medical ideas from the time?

Bring in you own knowledge too, don't just rely on what you can see in the source, what else do you know?

Week 5

Paper 1—History of Medicine

Who was more important in the development of surgery, James Simpson or Joseph Lister? Explain your answer carefully (8 marks) PLUS 3 for SPAG

Help Box

Firstly remember these men both helped with surgery and operations mostly so concentrate on that.

Think about Simpson—what did he do? When? What was good and not so good with his breakthrough?

Do the same with Lister

Then write a sentence or two saying which you think was more important and why.

Paper 1—History of Medicine

(7 marks)

Review the smallpox vaccination work and how it worked

Consider why people in the 19th century may have been less than keen with this idea.

Try to include a range of reasons (some may be religious, practical, snobbery, lack of knowledge etc etc)
