1. Be able to talk about what you do in your free time (present tense infinitives)

- Introduction to the course and target language refresher.
- Be able to give opinions using the infinitive of verbs to describe your free time preferences.

3. Be able to use present tense to describe what you do in your free time.

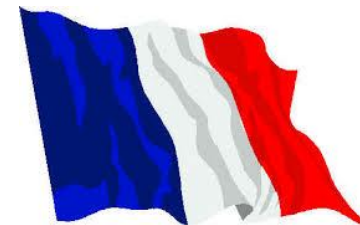
- Be able to use common regular verbs to write about what you do in your free time
- Be able to use common irregular verbs to describe what you do in your free time.

2. Tell someone what you will do in the future.

- Be able to use simple future tense and the key infinitives already taught to describe what you and others do in the future.

4. Be able to describe your eating habits.

- Be able to write about what you eat for breakfast.
- Be able to recognise key fruit and veg vocabulary and use these to order quantities at the market.
- Be able to recognise general food items and talk about your eating habits using the present tense.
- Be able to use simple future tense to describe what you will eat.
- Be able to write about what you ate and drank in the past.



5. Be able to order food.

- Be able to use the food vocabulary learnt to understand a food menu.
- Be able to order food in a restaurant and understand complaints about food.

6. Be able to talk about where you live.

- Be able to recognise countries and compass points in French
- Be able to recognise and write about types of housing and location.

7. Be able to tell someone about where you live.

- Be able to describe rooms in the house
- Be able to describe your bedroom using furniture vocabulary
- Be able to use prepositions to describe your bedroom
- Be able to describe what your house will look like in the future.

8. Be able to talk about helping at home and pocket money

- Be able to talk about how you help at home
- Be able to explain how much pocket money you get.
- Be able to describe your daily routine.
