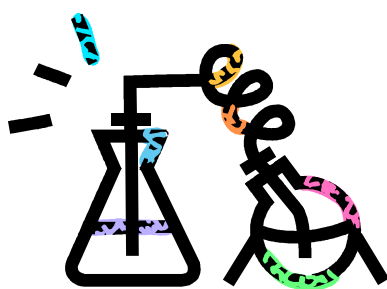

Two exam papers (1 hour 45 minutes each). Each paper is worth 50% of the GCSE.

WHAT YOU WILL STUDY:

Biology: cell biology / bioenergetics

Chemistry: quantitative chemistry/ chemistry of the atmosphere

Physics: waves/ space physics.

WHO SHOULD DO IT?

Triple Science is an option for students who are aiming for 9,8,7 or 6 grades. It is advisable to do this if you wish to have a Science related career or to study it at A Level.

Triple Science is challenging, rewarding and looked upon as a valuable qualification by both employers and universities.

Students should be at least at level 6a by the end of Year 9 in both maths and science.
